The Town of Sunapee enforces the Ordinance for Control and Use of Alcoholic Beverages. I have read the Control and Use of Alcoholic Beverages in the Town of Sunapee Ordinance. If approved by the Selectmen, I understand:

- a. Alcohol will not be sold.
- b. I will designate a person over the age of 21 who will be responsible for monitoring the event for appropriate alcohol consumption by attendees.
- c. I will designate two drivers who will not consume any alcohol and who will be available until the end of the event.
- d. I am responsible for terminating the event by midnight.
- e. I agree that random police checks may be made at any time.
- f. I understand all relevant State laws must be complied with.
- g. I understand I must obtain liability insurance in the amount of \$300,000 and a copy must be filed with the Board of Selectmen before use of alcohol will be permitted.
- h. If alcoholic beverages are permitted the applicant shall be required to also furnish to the Selectmen's Office, at least ten (10) days prior to such function, written confirmation that the applicant has secured a liquor liability insurance policy in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.**

AN ORDINANCE

**Control and Use of Alcoholic Beverages
In the Town of Sunapee**

THE TOWN OF SUNAPEE ORDAINS:

- Section 1: It shall be unlawful to consume, attempt to consume, or possess any container, with factory seal broken, having therein any alcoholic liquor or malt beverage in or on any property owned by the Town of Sunapee.
- Section 2: Alcoholic beverages and malt beverages shall include all distilled liquors or rectified, spirits, vinous, fermented, brewed and malt liquors, any beverage by whatever name called, having an alcoholic content of not less than ½ percent of alcohol by volume and more than 6 percent alcohol by volume at 60 degrees Fahrenheit; and any beverage if which any part is an alcoholic liquor or malt beverage. (RSA 175:1 VIII)
- Section 3: The Board of Selectmen, upon application, may issue a permit to any person, group or corporation for the consumption of alcoholic liquors or malt beverages within a prohibited area. Such terms and conditions Of permit will be set by the Board of Selectmen. They may charge a reasonable fee for such permit.
- Section 4 A first offenses shall be punishable by a \$100.00 fine. All subsequent offenses shall be punishable by a \$250.00 fine.
- Section 5 All fines shall be paid at the Sunapee Town Hall or the Sunapee Police Department, Monday through Friday during normal business hours.
